## *Double attack*

### *Solutions to Test 1*

1. Bök-Saila, Stockholm, 1946.  
1 Qe5!! Resigns.
2. Szabó-Bán, Budapest, 1947.  
1 Qe5!! Qf8 2 Qxf4! Resigns.
3. Tolush-Simagin, Moscow, 1952.  
1 ... Qg1+! 2 Kxg1 Nxe2+ White resigns.
4. Gligoric-Smyslov, Amsterdam, 1971.  
1 ... Qf4!! White resigns. (Any move by the rook is answered by 2 ... Rxf3! 3 Qxf3 Bxe4.)
5. Shportko-Kashenko, Corr., 1972-4.  
1 Nc5!! Resigns. (Against the two threats of 2 Qg4+ and 2 Bd7+ there is no defence.)
6. Bassler-Scheichel, Groningen, 1972.  
1 ... Nxg3! White resigns (2 Nxf5 Ncxe2+!, or 2 Qxg3 Nxe2+).
7. Krogius-Martyushov, Tula, 1949.  
1 Qc6!! Resigns (1 ... Qxc6 2 Nxe7+ and 3 Nxc6).
